### Good Friday Reflection

1. Which of the three attitudes identified in the message do you see in your behavior towards God (rebellion/sin, rejection of God, and hiding from God)? Describe how these attitudes manifest in your life.
2. In contrast to these attitudes, Jesus gave us forgiveness, acceptance, and an invitation unto Him. He gave up His life so that you can have yours. Are you willing to make changes in your life in response to what Jesus Christ did for you? Think of steps you can take to start making changes to your attitude towards God.

### Easter Reflection

1. What is your life's purpose? Does the way you are living today reflect that purpose, and does it bring you joy, satisfaction, and excitement?
2. Identify things that are keeping you from running the race of life with purpose: things you do out of necessity but do not bring you joy, and things you do out of obligation that make you feel empty and unsatisfied.
3. What are the things you can start doing so that your actions reflect your purpose as a follower of Jesus—the purpose to proclaim that our Savior is alive and to glorify Him by living out His Word?
